Throughout the Church's life, the written word (chiefly the Bible, but also all kinds of other texts) and its power to form individuals has always been an important part of how women and men grow into better lovers of God and neighbor. While it's important to say that reading is most certainly not everything (see James 1:27), the cultivation of a renewed imagination for the world and one's place in it is also not nothing (see Romans 12:2).

However, if you go by the statistics, for a variety of reasons Americans are 1) reading fewer and fewer books each year and 2) publishing more books than ever before.

This means that when we actually do decide to sit down and read, it can be difficult to figure out what to actually pick up! In an attempt to offer some small remedy to this situation, we thought it could be helpful to collect a list of books from a variety of genres that we think will cultivate in anyone an increased love of and desire for the Good, the True, and the Beautiful - that is, love of and desire for God himself.

Of course, this is a working list that is not exhaustive, and is certain to expand and contract periodically! <u>But it is a good place to start</u> if you're looking for direction.

You'll notice that there's a good bit of fiction on this list (there could, and likely will be, even more than we've included!). If fiction isn't your first choice, I'll simply encourage you to take a chance to let a story show you Good, True, and Beautiful things: it is a different mode of thinking, but one that I'm convinced we need to recover to be more faithfully present in our time.

One last note: I've put in BOLD my personal favorites. Take them or leave them, of course. But probably take them because they're great.
